



**The Thomas Butterfield Community Service Scholarship**  
Originated and Established June 2001

**The Amount of this scholarship shall be \$1,000 (one thousand dollars)**

**1. Applicant Requirements.**

- A. Must be a resident of Herriman for at least 12 (twelve) months prior to submitting application.
- B. Must have performed a minimum of **24 hours** of community service for the City of Herriman, or residents of Herriman, with the service being specific only to this award, and not including other projects or years of service.
- C. Submit an essay that describes the service given, hours, and involvement of others. This may include but not be limited to: visual aids, photos, videos, drawings, time served, reports, etc.
- D. Finalists will be interviewed and notified prior to award being granted. Applicants will be notified of the status of the award before Fort Herriman Days.
- E. Applicants are eligible for award within five years of completing high school graduation requirements and receipt of diploma, and may apply as many times as desired within that five-year period for the annual award.
- F. A check for \$500 will be issued upon proof of acceptance and registration for the first semester to the university, college, trade school or any institute of high learning. The second check of \$500 will be issued in the same manner after proof of acceptance for the second semester, and after maintaining a grade point average of 2.5.

**II. One award will be available each year, and will be presented at the annual Fort Herriman Days Celebration. High school GPA will not be part of the judging criteria. Applicants will be judged on the following criteria:**
