Attention all Builders and Contractors:

Due to the different types of soil being found throughout Herriman City, as of October 1, 2006, **ALL** footing excavations shall have a <u>state licensed</u> geotechnical engineer or agency give the City Building Inspector a

COMPREHENSIVE ENGINEERING ANALYSIS (SOILS REPORT)

This analysis shall give the type of soils and also any recommendations for design. This is in compliance with the International Residential Code, R401.4

R401.4 **Soils tests** In areas likely to have expansive, compressible, shifting or other unknown soils characteristics, the building official shall determine whether to require a soil test to determine the soil's characteristics at a particular location. This test shall be made by an approved agency using an approved method.

The Herriman City Building Official has determined this is needed on <u>all lots</u>.
