OVER 60 YEARS OF PROFESSIONAL RODEO

The Bar T Rodeo was founded in the Red Rocks of Moab Utah 60+ years ago by Cowboy hall of famer D.A. Swanny Kerby & Wife Verda Kerby. D.A. Swanny Kerby brought the first Rodeo to Utah and continued to produce top quality PRCA rodeos all across the western United States taking bucking stock to the first National Finals Rodeo in 1959 in Dallas Texas. Son Bud Kerby and Wife Evelyn took the Bar T Rodeo to the next level making it a state icon and one of the top Sought after Rodeo Company's in the United States. Bud a saddle Bronc Rider and Pick up Man was highly respected as one of the best Bucking Horse Men in the industry. He built a Breeding program that today is one of the most sought after horse herds in the world. In 2002 Bar T Rodeo helped produce the first Olympic Rodeo in Farmington Utah.

Bar T Rodeo has won two Remuda Awards 2005 & 2011. They have won Horse of the year with Alley Cat and Sparrow. In 2011 Fancy Pants won best Saddle bronc of the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo. 2011 Bitter Robin Bare Back horse, 8 Ball Saddle Bronc Horse and -8 Top Gun Bull won 1st place for animal of the year for the Wilderness Circuit Rodeo. Bar T Rodeo has won many years of the top stock awards for the Wilderness Circuit. In 2011 Bar T Rodeo came home with four go round buckles from the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo. Bar T Rodeo has had stock at all Wrangler National Finals Rodeo's since 1959.

12 years ago Son In-law and Daughter Jeff and Wendie Flitton started a Bull breeding program. Many of the raised bulls have been to the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas Nevada.

Today the Bar T Rodeo is owned by the 3rd Generation Daughter Wendie Flitton and Husband Jeff Flitton along with 4th Generation Son Cody Flitton a Pick up Man. The Bar T is run and operated by many of the family members, such as the matriarch mother Evelyn Kerby, Daughter and Son Inlay Sam and Kellie Addington, Sister and brother In-law Lori and Martin Pierce who all love the family heritage and the sport of Rodeo. The Bar T Rodeo family work hard maintaining the quality Bucking Horses and Bucking Bulls that the Bar T Rodeo has been known for.

Cowboys like coming to Bar T Rodeo's for they know they all have a fair opportunity to be number one.

We at the Bar T Rodeo have a goal to preserve the western heritage and our Sport of Rodeo. We want to make sure that for many years to come generations of family's have the opportunity to enjoy a Quality PRCA Rodeo.
