### HOBBY/FANCIERS LICENCE CHECK LIST

The items on this check list **MUST BE** completed before you will be considered for a hobby/fanciers permit.

- Verified lot size of at least 10 thousand (10,000) square feet as verified by a legal description of your property.
- Kennels must be at least thirty five (35) feet from neighboring dwellings
- Minimum size for outdoor kennels must be as follows:
  - o 32 square feet for dogs over 50 lbs.
  - o 18 square feet for dogs 15-50 lbs.
  - o 16 square feet for dogs 15 lbs. or less
- Animals must have adequate shelter and protection from the elements. Each dog must be provided a shelter <u>within</u> its outside dog kennel
- All fencing shall be maintained to prevent injury and/or escape to the enclosed animal(s)
- Kennels must be kept cleaned and maintained to prevent accumulations of the animal waste, litter, debris or trash
- Food must be stored in a container which prevents contamination
- The yard must be free of health hazards, such as brush or rubbish that rodents can live in
- Access to fresh water provided at all times
- Noise control (licensee will be required to prevent excessive noise disturbance by dog's at the residence.
- All dogs four (4) months or older must be current on rabies vaccinations.

When you have your kennel area ready, please call Herriman Animal Services at 801-758-0080 to schedule a final inspection appointment.

<u>NOTE:</u> After your approval you are subject to random unannounced inspections and you must have Animal Services inspect your kennels on a yearly basis before your permit will be renewed.

# TITLE 5 PUBLIC SAFETY

# CHAPTER 1 ANIMAL SERVICES

#### 5-1C-11: HOBBY PERMIT:

Where permitted by the Zoning Ordinances, owners of dogs, cats and ferrets may obtain a permit to keep more than three (3) dogs or cats, or two (2) ferrets, in a residential area, provided:

- A. Such pets are individually licensed;
- B. Such pets are rendered sterile:
- C. Complies with zoning requirements;
- D. Approval is granted by the Director/Coordinator;
- E. Adequate areas for confinement and shelter are provided; and
- F. Other provisions of this chapter are complied with, and no pet or premises is deemed to be a nuisance. (Ord. 2019-21, 6-26-2019, eff. 7-1-2019)

#### 5-1C-10: FANCIER PERMIT; AUTHORIZED WHEN:

- A. Where permitted by the Zoning Ordinances, owners of purebred dogs and cats may obtain a permit to keep more than three (3) dogs or cats in a residential area, provided:
  - 1. Such pets are individually licensed;
- 2. Such pets are registered with a national registry, such as, but not limited to, the AKC, UKC or Field Dog;
  - 3. Complies with zoning requirements and the Director/Coordinator;
  - 4. Appeal is granted by the Director/Coordinator;
  - 5. Adequate areas for shelter and confinement are provided; and
- 6. All other provisions of this chapter are complied with, and no pet or premises is deemed to be a nuisance.
- B. The holder of a permit issued under this section may keep one litter intact until the animals reach five (5) months of age; one animal from the litter may be retained until it reaches twelve (12) months of age. At no time may the holder of a permit retain more animals than is indicated on the permit. (Ord. 2019-21, 6-26-2019, eff. 7-1-2019)
