

# Fort Herriman Towne Days Cornhole Tournament

Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup> • 6-9 PM

**Recreational/Social division.** Ages 13+ welcome.

Number of teams is limited, so register early!

\*This is not an official league competition and boards and bags may not meet league regulation. \*

## **Registration description:**

This is a double elimination cornhole tournament for teens and adults. Blind draw/randomly filled bracket. Each team is made up of 2 people. Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams.

Registration is done as a team and is \$40 per team. (Price includes a t-shirt for each team member.) You may bring your own bags, or use the ones provided. If a team no shows or fails to have enough players a forfeit is recorded, no refunds.

## **Scoring**

Games are played to 21 or more points. (no bust) Cancellation scoring: In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each frame.

1 point – any bag that has been pitched and remains on the cornhole board playing surface at the conclusion of the frame. (Bags don't count if they are touching the ground or bounced first and then hit the board.)

3 points – any bag that has been pitched and passes through the cornhole board hole at any time within the frame.

## **Game Rules**

Team A competes against Team B – each team is comprised of 2 people.

Each team will stay in their designated lane for the whole game. Teams will be playing across from each other in the same lane. Each board should be playing a member of the opposing team.

Players at one board will alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all 4 bags.

Each player gets 1 frame to warm up then scoring begins. (Down and back.)

Players at the other board will take score and resume pitching back to the other cornhole board.

Bags must be delivered/pitched with an underhand release.

Feet must stay behind the line in the front of the board at the time of releasing the bag.

The player/team that scored in the preceding frame pitches first in the next frame. If neither player/team scores, the player/team who pitched first in the preceding frame shall retain first pitch in the next frame.

Boards are placed 27 feet from front edge to front edge.

Required information for registration.

Player 1 First and Last name, phone number and email.

Player 2 First and last name, phone number and email.

Registration closes when we hit 32 teams signed up. Must sign up as a team.
