Herriman City Experiences 5.7 Magnitude Earthquake

HERRIMAN, Utah—Herriman City, along with other areas in northern Utah, experienced a 5.7 magnitude earthquake at approximately 7:10 a.m. Wednesday morning. Aftershocks are continuing to be felt across the area.

Herriman City ~~offices are closed for the day~~ and all nonessential employees have been sent home. City public works crews are verifying the safety of infrastructure throughout the city. Water emergencies can be called in to the City's main phone number, 801-446-5323, to be forwarded to the Public Works Department to handle in order of highest priority. Life and safety emergencies should be called in to 9-1-1. All other standard City services are on hold.

Brick damage to Silvercrest Elementary School and Blackridge Elementary School has been reported and is being addressed by Jordan School District. We ask the public to stay clear of the area.
