## Council Corner

### Maximizing Your Tax Dollars and Fire Safety

One of the City Council's essential duties is fiscal responsibility. We do our best to channel the tax funds that come from your hard-earned dollars to provide a direct benefit to our own community. To that end, on Wednesday, August 26th, the City Council voted to provide notice of withdrawal from the Unified Fire Service Area (UFSA) taxing district. This decision was carefully vetted after several meetings with UFSA and in-depth discussion during City Council meetings on June 10th and 24th, and August 12th, 19th, and 26th. We want to make it clear that we are grateful for and pleased with the quality of service we receive from the Unified Fire Authority (UFA)—our local fire department—and that the Council made this decision simply to maximize Herriman residents' tax dollars within our community.

To be clear, the UFSA is only a mechanism that multiple municipalities can participate in that allocates property tax money to fund UFA operations. UFSA and UFA are separate entities. In other words, the UFSA (taxing district) is an optional money pool to help pay for UFA (fire department).

This decision by the Council will simply remove Herriman City from participation in the UFSA taxing entity and allow the City to form its own fire-specific taxing entity. The transition will provide greater local control over the fire service portion of Herriman property tax funds and how they are distributed. This will allow the collected funds to be directly invested in providing service to our community. The new Herriman City fire service area (to be named later) will replace the UFSA portion of our residents' property taxes.

We will continue our contracted partnership with UFA to provide their exceptional fire service. We are grateful to them for thorough coordination through this process.





**An Extra Eye on Your Safety**

Think about the building you're in right now. It's probably your home. If you're lucky, it might be a pavilion at one of our beautiful parks. For others, it might be your office, a school, museum, or public building. We spend about 90% of our lives in buildings.

Did you know that each of those buildings was inspected by a certified Building Inspector?

The job of the Herriman City Building Department is to be a second set of eyes to help ensure the contractor complies with all building code requirements. From structural safety, to safe electrical design, to paths of escape – we make sure nothing gets missed.

Our Plans Examiners review construction design and engineering to verify that it complies with the current building code. Then our Building

Inspectors watch the construction from footing to roof to make sure that all concrete, framing, plumbing, mechanical, and electrical components are placed to match the approved plans.

Each of Herriman's building inspectors is State-certified and continues to complete courses to keep current on safety updates and new products. We do this to help contractors give you a better product and peace of mind.
