Basic Information

The garden is gated

One plot per household

Plot Sizes & Pricing

Single Plots are 30 feet long with 3 full rows and 2 half rows
\$40

Double Plots are 30 feet long with 6 full rows and 2 half rows
\$60

This money is refunded to you at the end of the season if you remain a gardener in good standing.

Organic gardening is required.

All plots needs to be **cultivated** by **Memorial Day**. Uncultivated Plots will be redistributed to the annual wait-list and all fees or deposits will be forfeited.





Members **who do not** comply with the Membership Agreement **may forfeit** their garden plot and any and all fees.

Members are required to attend:

- 1 irrigation pull
- 1 community weed day
- 1 donation harvest

Members must keep their Plots and walkways well maintained, free of weeds and debris. Members should make every effort to control invasive weeds, pests, and disease. Weeds should be pulled and not allowed to go to seed.

If you do not maintain your plot, you will receive a “notice to repair” from the committee or City staff. You must acknowledge the notice within 3 days by responding to the Garden Committee Chair via email or telephone. Within 7 days of receiving the notice, improvement in maintenance must be demonstrated. If maintenance is not completed within 14 days, you may lose your Plot and membership in the Garden.

Members should not use chemicals to control pests or weeds (Including traditional Preen, organic Preen, any germination blocking item); The Garden encourages organic gardening.

Once you register you will receive emails from the Community Garden Committee giving you further information regarding the organization of the garden.

- Review Transaction


